

- Click the link to view the items enter your TOTAL quantity for each item sold.
- You are placing an order for TOTAL items sold to all your customers not one per customer.
- After completing the form submit it.
- You will receive email confirmation of your order.


4. Payment and Payment Options

- Payment is due on the day of pick-up.
- You must write ONE check for the total of all items ordered we cannot accept direct checks from your customers. We cannot accept cash for your order.
- If you placed orders for multiple fundraisers, delivering on the same day we require a separate check for EACH fundraiser.
- Include your child's name and fundraiser name in the check memo.
- Payment can also be made via Money Order or PayPal. A 3% fee will be added to your order total for PayPal payments.
- Checks for fundraiser payments (only) are held for ONE WEEK to allow you time to collect payment from your customers. It should be expected that they will be deposited exactly ONE WEEK after the fundraiser delivery date.
- Any checks returned for non-sufficient funds will result in:
 - A replacement check or money order being required to pay for the fundraiser items.
 - An additional fee to reimburse LHSBG&OPC for bank fees incurred.
 - The removal of quota contribution for the fundraiser from the student's account, until such time that the fundraiser and fees are paid in full.

4. Payment and Payment Options – example of how to write out the check

5. Quota and overpayments/refunds with an example

Overpayments:

- Fundraisers are made available throughout the school year, and may be used to cover the quota costs required for a student *during that current school year*. For example, if this school year is the 2022-23 school year, the student can fundraise throughout the 2022-23 school year, to cover quota expenses incurred for the 2022-23 school year.
- Fundraised funds CANNOT be used to be reimbursed for quota expenses incurred in prior school years.
 For example, if the student took a trip in the 2021-22 school year, he/she may not use fundraised funds earned in the 2022-23 school year to be reimbursed for the trip costs from the previous school year.
- If the amount fundraised by the student in the school year exceeds the student's quota obligation for that same school year, the fundraised funds CAN be rolled over in the student's account for use to cover the following school year's quota expenses. *Any rolled over funds become non-refundable.*
- If an overpayment occurs in the student's quota account, the family is eligible for a refund of any direct payments made towards the student's quota expenses for that school year. These refunds will be calculated by the Executive Board at the end of each school year, and a check will be automatically mailed to the family in the proper amount. This allows the family to continue to fundraise to cover the cost of a trip, even though payments to participate in that trip may have been due prior to additional available fundraising opportunities

Liberty Band Refund - Example

- 2022-23 school year, student's financial obligation is \$150 (fair share) + \$1500 (if going on the trip). Total obligation = \$1650.
- Student has the opportunity to fundraise to pay for both fair share and trip costs.
- Final Trip payment is due Feb 1.
- Prior to Feb 1, the student has fundraised **\$1200** and applied that to their total obligation. The student's family writes a check for the remainder owed **(\$450**).
- Between Feb 1 and last day of 2022-23 school year, the student fundraises an additional **\$500**.
- The student's family will receive a refund check to be reimbursed for the amount paid in **(\$450**) *during the current school year*. The student cannot request a refund of the additional **\$50** raised.
- The remaining \$50 will be rolled over for next year's use if underclassman. If the student is a senior, that
 \$50 must be transferred to another student in the program or entering the program the following year,
 OR donated to the general fund.
- Each year, students who fundraise enough to cover their financial obligations for the year will
 <u>automatically</u> receive a refund check for any 'paid-in' amount (in the example case = \$450) from that
 school year. Any additional amount (in the example case = \$50) will be rolled over for next year, or
 donated to another student/general band fund.
- This is a year-to-year process. Parents cannot fundraise to be reimbursed for any funds paid-in to cover expenses incurred in previous school years.

- Quota will no longer be posted on the website.
- Instead, we will use the Charms System.
- Benefits of the Charms System:
 - Allows each family access to their own student(s)'s account to view their quota balance at any time
 - Provides line item view as to what is included in the quota amount
 - Allows administrators to update additions to quota amounts more quickly and make it more visible to parents and students
 - Allows parents to request to use their quota amounts to cover financial obligations/expenses for the school year.

6. Getting parents access to Charms

- Band students and a few choir students are entered, with their accounts up to date.
- Orchestra only students expected to be set up within the first two weeks of school.
- Choir students will be entered as they sign up for the trip.
- Students/parents need to set up their account
- The student's BASD email will be the primary email on the account for set up purposes.
- A parent guide is posted in the 'Information > LHSGB&OPC' section of the website

Process for getting parents/students set up:

- We will ask Charms to reset ALL student passwords.
- Once this is done, we will put an announcement up in the Band App.
- You will receive an email to your <u>student's BASD email</u> with a link to reset their password.
- Use the Parent Guide on the website to get the school code.
- The link is only good for 24 hrs until the password must be reset again.
- Once you have set up the account, you can add adult contact information, phone numbers, emails, so that you can receive email and text communications sent out by the board.

- Make sure you can get access to your student's BASD email account (for Charms reset password email)
- Watch for the Band App announcement that Charms passwords have been reset
