



## *Program Notes*

### **AN OUTDOOR OVERTURE**

Aaron Copland began work on the *Outdoor Overture* in mid October, 1938, and completed it in less than four weeks. When he played the sketch for Alex Richter, who was director of music at New York's High School of Music and Art, both men were attracted to the open-air qualities of the overture. Together they decided on the title.

### **AMERICAN SALUTE**

Morton Gould uses the famous Civil War song "When Johnnie Comes Marching Home" as the theme of his *American Salute*. It is interesting to note the author and composer of this marching song uses the name Louis Lambert, in reality a pseudonym of the great bandmaster Patrick S. Gilmore.
