The Appian Way, oldest of Roman roads, extends from Rome to Capua. It was used by the Roman legions as an entrance to, and exit from, Rome. In this music one can hear the many sounds of armies on the move, some hurrying to a new crisis and some returning in stately fashion with bugles blaring. "Pines of the Appian Way" is the fourth and last part of Respighi's symphonic poem, PINES OF ROME, in which he expresses his feeling for the Rome he knew, inspired by the pines in its gardens, beside one of its catacombs, on its hills and along the Appian Way.
