9. Street Drill Music for Knoxville, Tenn.

On April 9, 1980 the L.H.S.G.B. will be competing with eighty other high school bands in Knoxville, Tenn. Areas of competition include concert band, parade, street drill, and stage band. This evening we are presenting a "compact" version of our street drill. The street drill rules state that you may perform in front of the judges for two minutes — clock to begin on first note of music. The band must begin to move out of judging area five seconds after the allotted two minutes performance time. The Grenadiers are attempting to play five separate pieces of music in this brief period of time. For a band as large as the Grenadiers (258 members) this is no easy task. Join in timing them and see if they make it.
