The first post horn heard in Bethlehem could very well have been from the top of South Mountain to alert the innkeepers in Bethlehem that the north north bound stage had reached the summit and soon would be arriving. Besides being the "horn" for stage coaches, canal boats, and the like, this tricky, 2½ ft. brass pipe has always been synonymous with calling the horses to "post" just before the race.
8. RIENZI OVERTURE ..... *R. Wagner*  
Richard Wagner's spectacular six hour opera "Rienzi" is based on Bulwer-Lytton novel, *The Last of the Roman Tribunes*. Completed in 1840, "Rienzi Overture" includes all the principal themes. The overture begins with a sustained "A" played by the trumpet which is the trumpet call in the third act. Rienzi's prayer, the chorus of Roman citizens, and the battle hymn are all heard in the overture. Rienzi has always been considered one of the more challenging transcriptions for modern concert band.

## 1981-82 GRENADIERS

1981 marks the first time the Grenadiers have had possession of *three* major band trophies in the same year. The Miss America Parade (Atlantic City, N.J.) in September and the King Frost Parade (Hamburg, Pa.) in October brought first place victories to the Grenadiers. This September the Grenadiers will be the *Honor Band* on the boardwalk, leading off the 1982 Miss America Parade and escorting no less than Miss America, herself.

1981 was the third time that the Grenadiers have won *Florida's Governor's Cup* at St. Petersburg's Festival of States. The Grenadiers are the only band to have their name on this most prestigious trophy three times. With additional wins by Boyertown, Wilson of West Lawn, and Brownsville, Pennsylvania leads all other states in possession of this trophy.
