PROGRAM NOTES

Captain Roger Swift, Director of Music, Coldstream Guards, first joined the Army in 1960 as pianist and clarinetist with the Royal Engineers Staff Band at Aldershot. In 1972 he was selected to attend the Student Bandmasters' Course at the Royal Military School of Music, Kneller Hall. On graduation, he won eight major awards, including the Worshipful Company of Musicians Medal for the best student of the course, and was subsequently appointed Bandmaster, the Queen's Royal Irish Hussars, with whom he served for some five years in Paderborn, West Germany. He returned to Kneller Hall in 1979, on appointment as the School Bandmaster.

He was commissioned into the Light Infantry in 1981, as Director of Music, The Light Division, and was based in Winchester with the Headquarters Staff. In 1983 he moved to Blackdown, near Camberley in Surrey, on appointment as Director of Music, Royal Army Ordinance Corps Staff Band, with whom he toured extensively throughout Great Britain, Hong Kong, Germany and Cyprus. He had the honor to be appointed Director of Music, Coldstream Guards in November, 1985.

We are delighted and honored to have Captain Swift as our guest conductor.

WHO ARE THE COLDSTREAM GUARDS

The Coldstream Guards are a part of the Household Division of the British military. Other Regiments in the Household Division include The Life Guards, The Blues and Royals (mounted), The Grenadier Guards, The Scots Guards, The Irish Guards and the Welsh Guards. Guardsmen are renowned for their unique proficiency with which they carry out ceremonial duties, their steadfastness in battle, their self-discipline, smartness and reliability. The Coldstream Guards date all the way back to 1650 when they were raised on the orders of Oliver Cromwell to form Colonel Monck's Regiment of Foot. Each Regiment of the Household Division has its own band. Regiments take turns in the "Changing of the Guard" at Buckingham Palace every day at 1100 hours.

The Coldstream Band, one of the world's finest military bands, has *always* been the favorite of Mr. Sherry. He has used the Coldstream band as a model for the Liberty High School Band. The motto of the Coldstream is "Nulli Secundus" or "Second to to None."
