




THE 1998 ST. PETERSBURG TRIP

The St. Petersburg "Festival of States" and the Liberty "Grenadiers" -- for many, it's difficult to mention one without the other coming to mind. After all, it was in 1967 that the LHSGB first performed at the Festival, where it not only premiered the newly adopted Grenadier theme, but also walked away with its first national championship.

While in Florida during its 1970 visit, the band had grandstand seating at Cape Kennedy for the take-off of Apollo 13. While "Houston" might have had a "problem", the LHSGB certainly did not; having won both field show and parade categories at St. Pete. Upon their return home, the band was greeted by over 4,000 well-wishers in BASD Stadium. During the ceremony, Mayor Gordon Payrow made good on his promise to rename Pine Street, "Grenadier Boulevard", if the LHSGB returned victorious.

A testament to our students' determination and talent, the LHSGB consistently placed at subsequent Festivals: 1974 - 2nd place, parade; 1978 - 3rd place, field show; 1981 - 1st place, parade; and 1984 - 1st place, parade.

This time around, while the Grenadiers will compete as they always have for the Governor's Cup (parade), the Festival is not sponsoring a field show event. Instead, the LHSGB will perform in a more recent addition to the Festival line-up, the Concert Competition. Unchanged, however, is St. Pete's reputation as one of the country's oldest, most prestigious, community-sponsored band festivals.


The LHSGB will also make its Disney performing debut with not one, but two parades in Epcot and the Magic Kingdom. Of the approximately 3,000 high school bands that apply annually, Disney World accepts less than 1,000; and of those, only an average of *ten* are granted the privilege to perform twice in one visit.

Since many of our band parents are Grenadier alumni, the 1998 St. Pete/Disney trip represents not only an exciting adventure for our current band members, but also a nostalgic march down memory lane for their parents. The 1998 LHSGB proudly turns to look back at the accomplishments of past Grenadiers as but one source of inspiration for the upcoming performances at the Festival of States. Soon, our talented, young musicians will add yet another chapter to the overall Liberty / St. Petersburg story, one with a common theme of hard work, team spirit, and excellence.




