
LHSGB : 1998 National Champions St. Petersburg “Festival of States”

Immediately after last year's Spring Concert, the Grenadiers renewed tradition as they flew to the nationally acclaimed St. Petersburg “Festival of States”. The LHSGB also broke new ground with its first *musical* visit to Disney World. Disney encouraged the Band to parade not once, but twice - once through Epcot and once through the Magic Kingdom. Of the 3,000 high school bands that apply annually, Disney World accepts less than 1,000; and of those, *only* Liberty was permitted to parade twice within the same visit last year. After endearing themselves to literally thousands of new fans in Disney, the Grenadiers eagerly awaited their culminating journey to the Festival of States.

With the passing of 14 years since the Band's last visit, St. Pete residents, as well as our students and parents, regarded this as the homecoming of an old friend to the Festival. Along with a warm embrace from the “Suncoasters” came some well-founded and high expectations. As they were presented with the Governor's Cup by trip's end, this most recent group of students from Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, however, proved most worthy of their name - the Liberty High School Grenadiers!



**Guest Conductor - Major David J. Marshall, ARCM LTCL BBCM psm
Director of Music, Her Majesty's Band of the Coldstream Guard**

Major Marshall is no stranger to the LHSGB, nor to its audiences. He visited Liberty as Guest Conductor in 1995 and 1997. In 1994 and 1996, he and his magnificent band hosted the LHSGB, as our two ensembles performed jointly in Britain. Major Marshall has devoted himself to a distinguished career in music. In 1960, he joined the Somerset & Cornwall Light Infantry as a cornet player. After further service with The Light Infantry, he was selected to attend the Student Bandmaster's course at The Royal Military School of Music, Kneller Hall, in 1973. In 1975 he was appointed Bandmaster of The Worcestershire and Sherwood Foresters Regiment, with whom he toured throughout Great Britain, Belize, and West Germany. Having served as School Bandmaster at Kneller Hall, Major Marshall was commissioned into the Royal Tank Regiment as Director of Music, Royal Armoured Corps, in 1985. He was appointed Director of Music, Royal Corps of Transport at their Aldershot depot, in 1987. In September, 1990, he had the honor to be appointed Director of Music, Coldstream Guards.

In that Major Marshall will be retiring from the Coldstream Guards this year, we take this opportunity to thank him for all that he has done and continues to do for our students. We also extend Major Marshall and his wife, Shirley, all the best, as well as an open invitation to visit Bethlehem and renew our friendship well into the future.



**Guest Soloist: Band Sergeant Major Kevin Coates, WO I
Her Majesty's Band of the Coldstream Guards**

Band Sergeant Major Kevin John Coates was born in Worksop, Nottingham. At six years old he started to play the cornet in the local Salvation Army Band under the watchful eye of his father, The Bandmaster. In 1976 he enlisted into the Coldstream Guards and in 1977 attended the pupils course at the Royal Military School of Music, Kneller Hall. On the culmination of the course, he entered and won the coveted bronze metal in the Frank Wright cornet soloist competition. On the return to the Band, he progressed steadily through the ranks and in 1987 was rewarded when he was appointed principal cornet. With the Band, Kevin has performed in many concert halls throughout the world. He has made his name on his 'forte' instrument, the Post Horn. In 1990, he had the honour to be appointed Warrant Officer Class Two, The Band Sergeant Major, and later, in 1997, Warrant Officer Class One. He is responsible for the immaculate turnout, general discipline and high standard of performance everyone has come to expect of one of the finest army bands in the world. Kevin is currently the senior ranking Band Sergeant Major of all the Regiments.

He performed in the very first Coldstream/Liberty concert in Royal Albert Hall in 1986, and has since joined us here for our 1996 and 1997 Spring Concerts. Having been integral in coordinating our 1994 and 1996 England trips, Kevin has proven to be a steadfast friend to our band. We welcome him back, along with his wife, Jacqui, and his son, Ryan.
