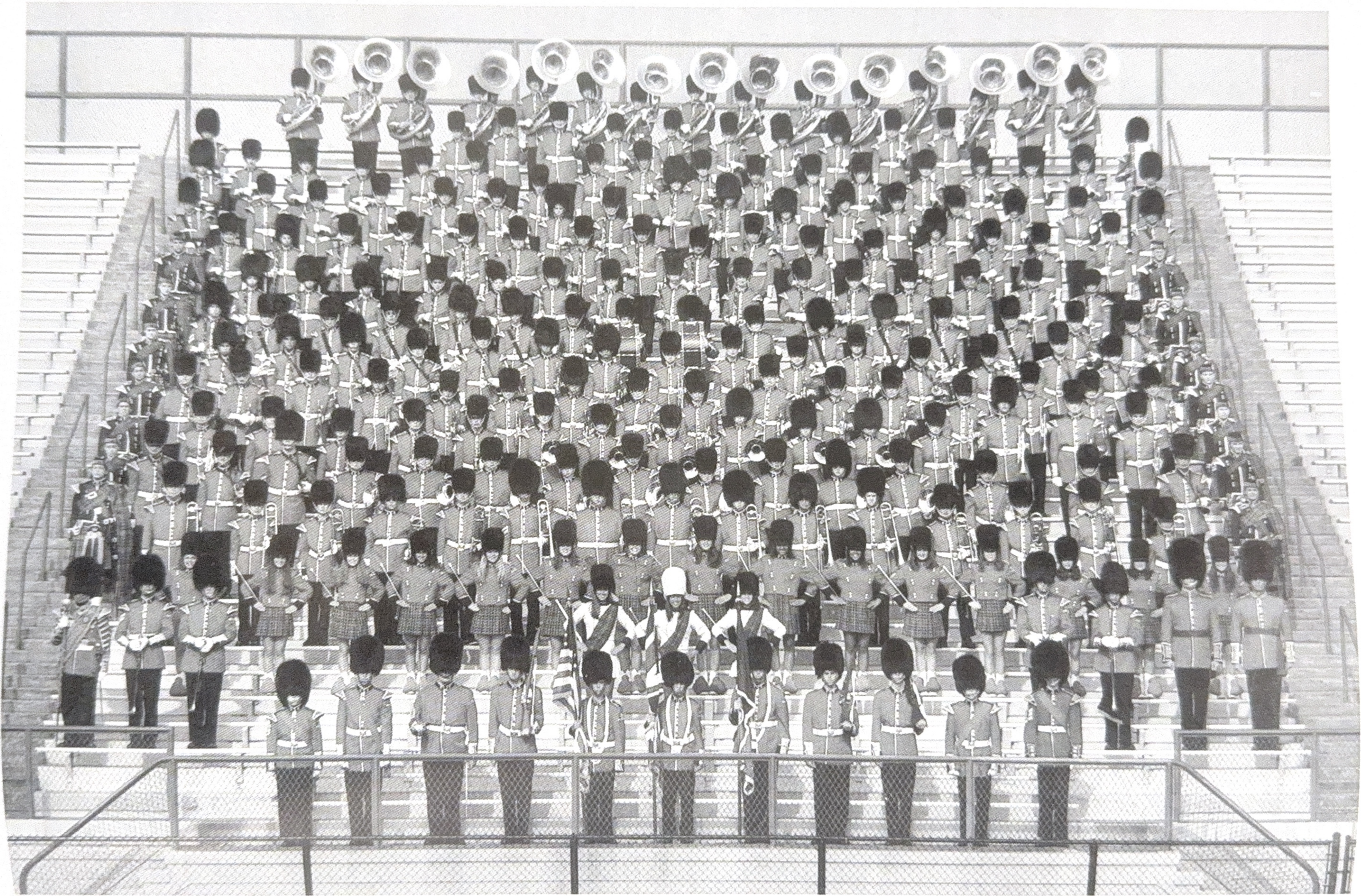

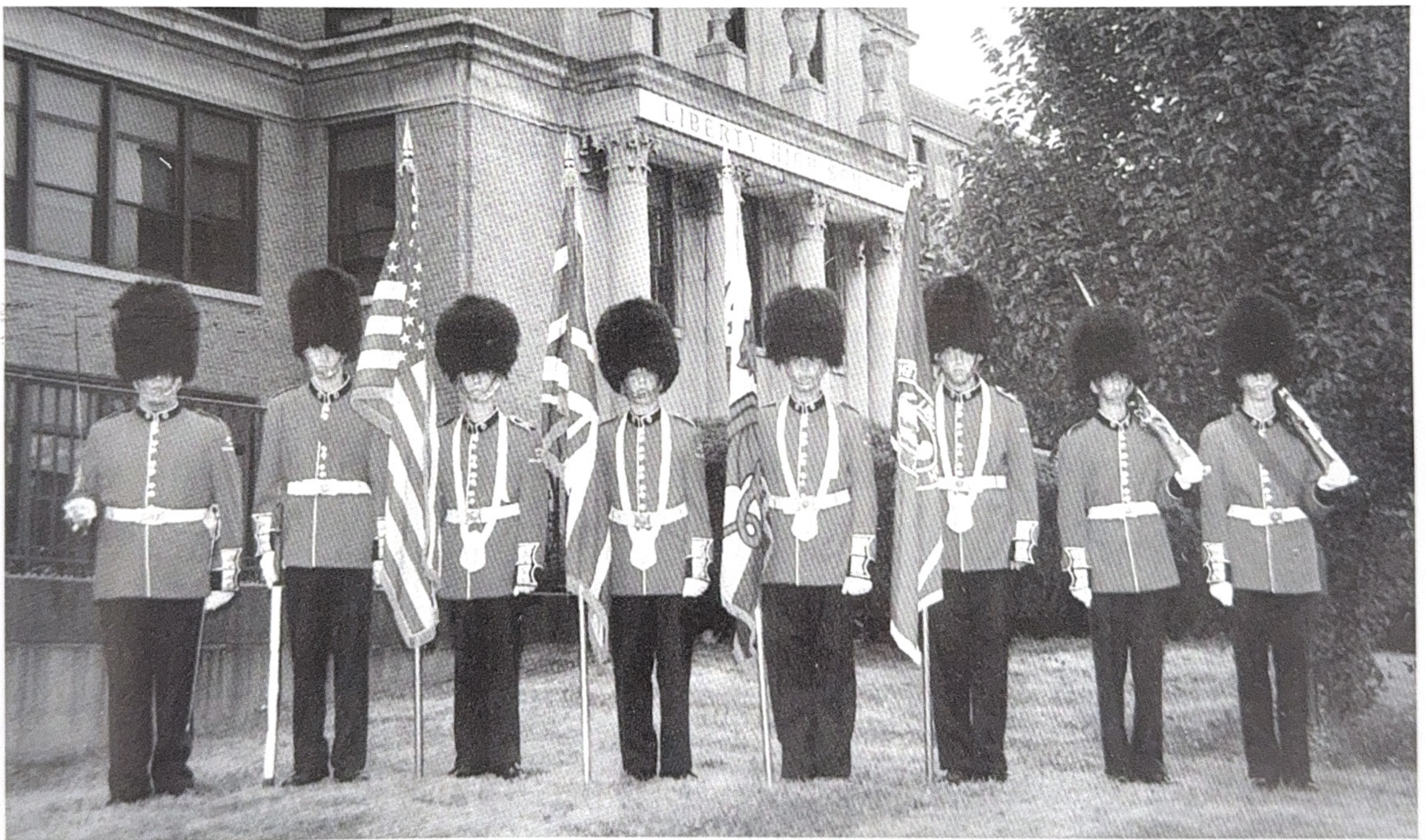

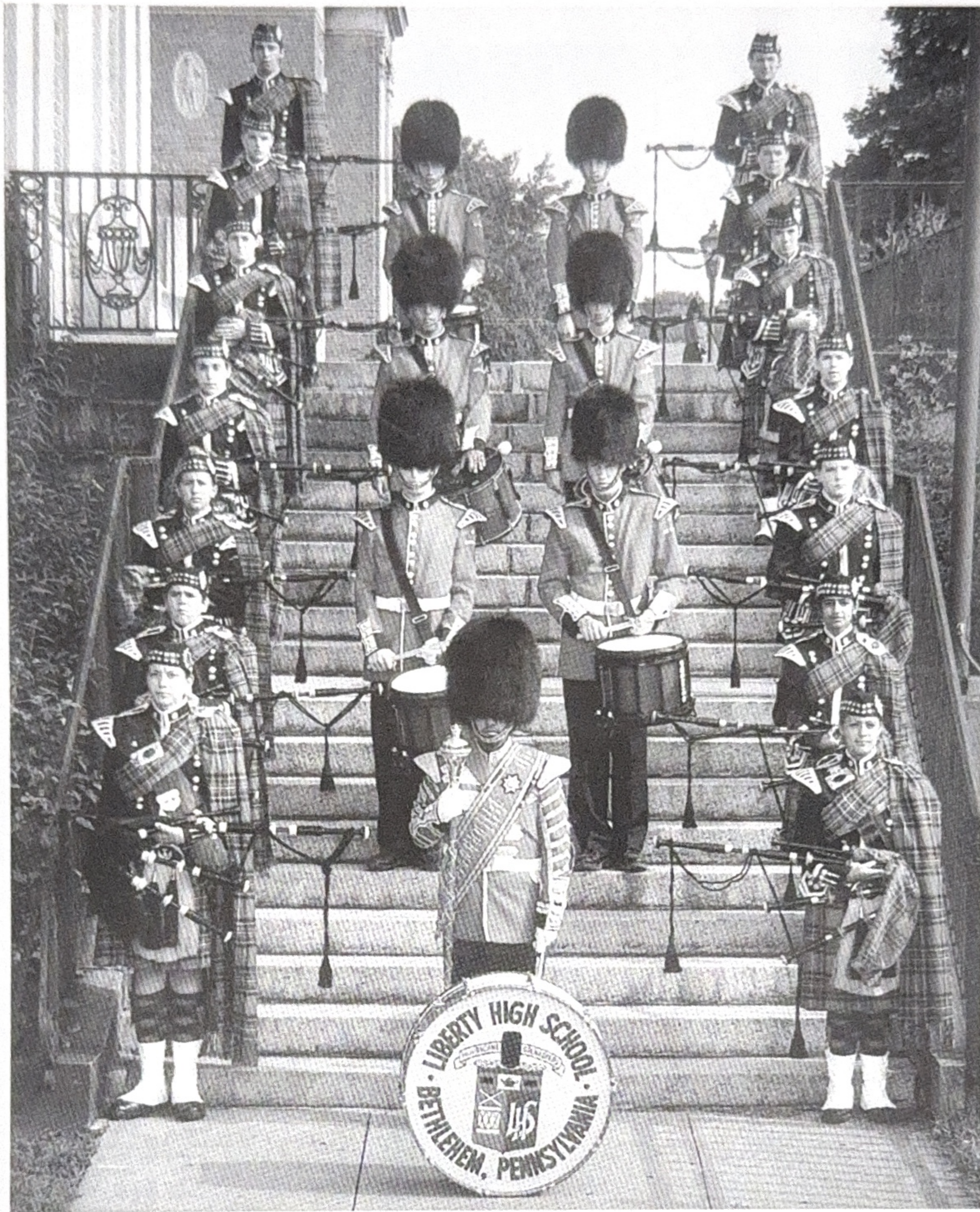

Major Jones originally started his military career studying the Harp with a world renowned Harpist, Maria Kachinska, while at the same time serving as a musician in the Royal Artillery Band. In 1981, he was selected to become a bandmaster and consequently attended the Royal Military School of Music, Kneller Hall, for three years, during which time he received prizes for both compositions and orchestrations.

Having left Kneller Hall, Major Jones was appointed to bandmaster of the 16<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> The Queen's Royal Lancers. With the amalgamation of that regiment among others in 1993, Major Jones was made a Member of the British Empire for his services to The Queen's Royal Lancers and was made bandmaster to The Royal Highland Fusiliers. One year later, in 1994, Graham was commissioned to the rank of Captain and was appointed Director of Music of The Band of the Scottish Division.

The year 1997 again brought something new when Major Jones moved to The Band of The Light Division. With this Band, he helped provide musical support in Bosnia and directed the Band while it was deployed to Kosovo, during the Balkans conflict. In 2000, Major Jones became the Officer Commanding the Training and Development Team of the Headquarters Army Music. While there, he pioneered the Army Accreditation Programme that is linked to the Trinity College of Music in London. In August 2001, Major Jones was appointed the Director of Music, Coldstream Guards, a position that remains unparalleled today in British Army Music.

Graham is married to Susan and has a daughter, Claudia. He is an accomplished arranger and orchestrator for modern wind band and has written several contemporary works and works dedicated to his family. Every member of the Grenadier Band and the Liberty community welcomes him to this, his first concert with us. It is a great honor to be under his leadership and we are hopeful that this is just the first of many great experiences we may share with him.



## **Guest Soloist: WO1 Kevin Coates MBE Regimental Band of Her Majesty's Coldstream Guards**

We are delighted to share the stage once again with Sergeant Major Kevin Coates of the Coldstream Band. Born in Worksop, Nottingham, Kevin first began to play the cornet in a local Salvation Army with the guidance of his father, the Bandmaster. In 1976, he enlisted into the Coldstream Guards and began in 1977 to attend courses at the Royal Military School of Music, Kneller Hall. At the conclusion of the *pupils* course, his first, Kevin won the coveted bronze metal in the Frank Wright Cornet Soloist Competition. Having joined the Coldstream Band, he progressed steadily through the ranks and was appointed Principal Cornetist in 1987. His hallmark is the Post Horn, which he has played in many concert halls throughout the world and has made quite a name for himself with.

Kevin, in 1990, had the honour to be appointed Warrant Officer Class Two and Band Sergeant Major. He was appointed Warrant Officer Class One (WO1) in 1997 and remains responsible today for the immaculate turnout, general discipline, and high standard of performance that are now synonymous with the Coldstream Guards Band, one of the finest army bands in the world. Most recently, in July 2001, Sergeant Major Coates was made a Member of "The Most Excellent Order of the British Empire", a very rare and extraordinary honour.

Having played in the very first Coldstream/Liberty concert at Royal Albert Hall in 1986, Kevin has remained an integral coordinator and close friend of the Grenadier Band. His playing tonight marks the fifth occasion on which he has joined the Liberty Band for its Spring Concert, having played in the 1996, 1997, 1999, and 2002 concerts. He has also played a vital role in the planning of the band's United Kingdom tours of 1994, 1996, and 2000. This past November, he and the Coldstream Band's fanfare team were a highly unexpected and pleasant surprise at the Freedom/Liberty football game where they joined the LHSGB for its pre-game and halftime shows. Only a few months later, in January of this year, Sergeant Major Coates again took the trip "across the pond", this time to help the First Company prepare for its floor show performance opening the Grenadier Guards and Black Watch Concert recently held at Stabler Arena. We again extend a very warm welcome to Kevin as he joins the Grenadier Band for another outstanding performance.
