Famed Native American performer, **Don Wild Eagle**, joins us this evening to provide narration for our musical selection, *Council Oak*. Mr. Wild eagle is a full-blooded Au-Authum (Pima)/Tinch (Apache) originally from the Salt River Pima Maricopa in Arizona. He is a Certified Wolf Clan Teacher, Traditional Dancer, and Peace Elder of the Wolf Clan Peace Elders Council. As a Peace Elder, he carries the Knowledge and Wisdom from the Elders Council to keep peace and to share with all. He is the eyes, ears and feet of the Elders, as they presently lead a less rigorous life style. As an appointed Peace Elder, Don realizes the importance, responsibility, and even obligation he has to sustain these traditions.

A teacher of Native American history, philosophy, artifacts, dancing, and songs for the past 12 years, he has made more than 50 television appearances, numerous school/youth presentations, and participates regularly at Native American Pow Wows throughout the United States. Because of his outstanding contributions, Mr. Wild Eagle has been recipient of numerous awards including the Peace Keeper from the International Gathering of Peace Elders (Brick City, Florida), Peace Elders Banner from the Wolf Song Elders Gathering (Texas), and the Medal of Honor from the Jim Thorpe Foundation. Don Wild Eagle is the official Northeastern United States Native American spokesperson for the Jim Thorpe Family.
